RECOMMENDATION:							
At the December 2007 Board Meeting, the Board approved the 2008-2009 school calendar which reflects 175 days instead of 180 days of student instruction.							
This expedited waiver allows the district to conduct staff development training by reducing the number of student instructional days, for a maximum of three days for general staff development, and a maximum of two days for staff development in the areas of Reading/Language Arts; Mathematics; Science; and/or Social Studies. These training dates will be used to train staff on various educational strategies designed to improve student performance.
