RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HIRING OF
CASUAL SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS FROM AN ESTABLISHED LIST
WITHOUT INDIVIDUAL BOARD APPROVAL

WHEREAS, the School Board has the power, pursuant to M.S. §12.35, to hire substitute teachers, and

WHEREAS, the School Board recognizes that it will be necessary to hire casual substitute teachers from time to time in order to fulfill the district's educational obligations;

WHEREAS, in order to consistently meet the academic needs of all students without interruption, the administration must be able to fill instructional vacancies, as they arise, without delay;
THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED THAT:

1. The School Board of Independent School District #595 hereby authorizes the school administration to establish and maintain an ongoing list of available casual substitute teachers.
2. The administration is hereby authorized to hire causal substitute teachers from such list as necessary without prior School Board approval for each individual hired in that capacity.
