RE: Proposed 2026 Summer School Rates and Calendar

Below are the proposed summer school rates for the 2026 summer school program. Summer school will be scheduled at both Lincoln Elementary and Roosevelt Middle School. There is no significant construction occurring at either building, so there should be no scheduling issues.

Summer 2025's fees were as follows:

Resident – \$214 per class for only 19 days, with a \$25 late fee (\$225 for a 20-day program)

Non-Resident – \$226 per class for only 19 days, with a \$25 late fee (\$280 for a 20-day program)

Remediative – \$129 for the four-week program

Roosevelt Readiness - \$86 for the five-day session

Based on the ongoing program net loss, we are proposing an increase of 6.7%. That equates to \$240 per class for a 20-day program.

Using that same percentage increase (rounded) for non-residents, it calculates to \$299 per class.

Using the same percentage increase and proration (rounded), the Remediative program rate is proposed at \$137 for the four-week program.

Using the same percentage increase (rounded), Roosevelt Readiness is proposed at \$91 for a five-day session. Two of the sessions will only be four days due to holidays. We recommend prorating the fee to \$73 for those sessions.

Teachers will be paid at a rate of \$58.09/hour, per the tentative collective bargaining agreement, which is 2.9% higher than the previous year. High School aides and college students/adults will both be paid at \$15.00/hour. Those rates are unchanged from the previous year. Per the collective bargaining agreement, current District 90 aides performing teaching assistant assignments will be paid at their current hourly rate, which ranges from \$22.45/ hour - \$30.37/hour.

Summer school administrators, per the tentative agreement, are allocated as follows:

Principal – \$6,005, or a 2.9% (CPI) increase from the prior year

Special Education Coordinator – \$6,005, or a 2.9% increase from the prior year

Nurse – \$4,005, or a 2.9% increase from the prior year

As noted above, this year the program will run for 21 days (20 instructional) from Wednesday, June 10, 2026 through Friday, July 10, 2026. Wednesday, June 10th serves as an orientation day, barring any cancelled days during the regular school year that may affect the beginning of the schedule. Friday, June 19th will be the Juneteenth observance and Friday, July 3rd will be the Independence Day observance.
