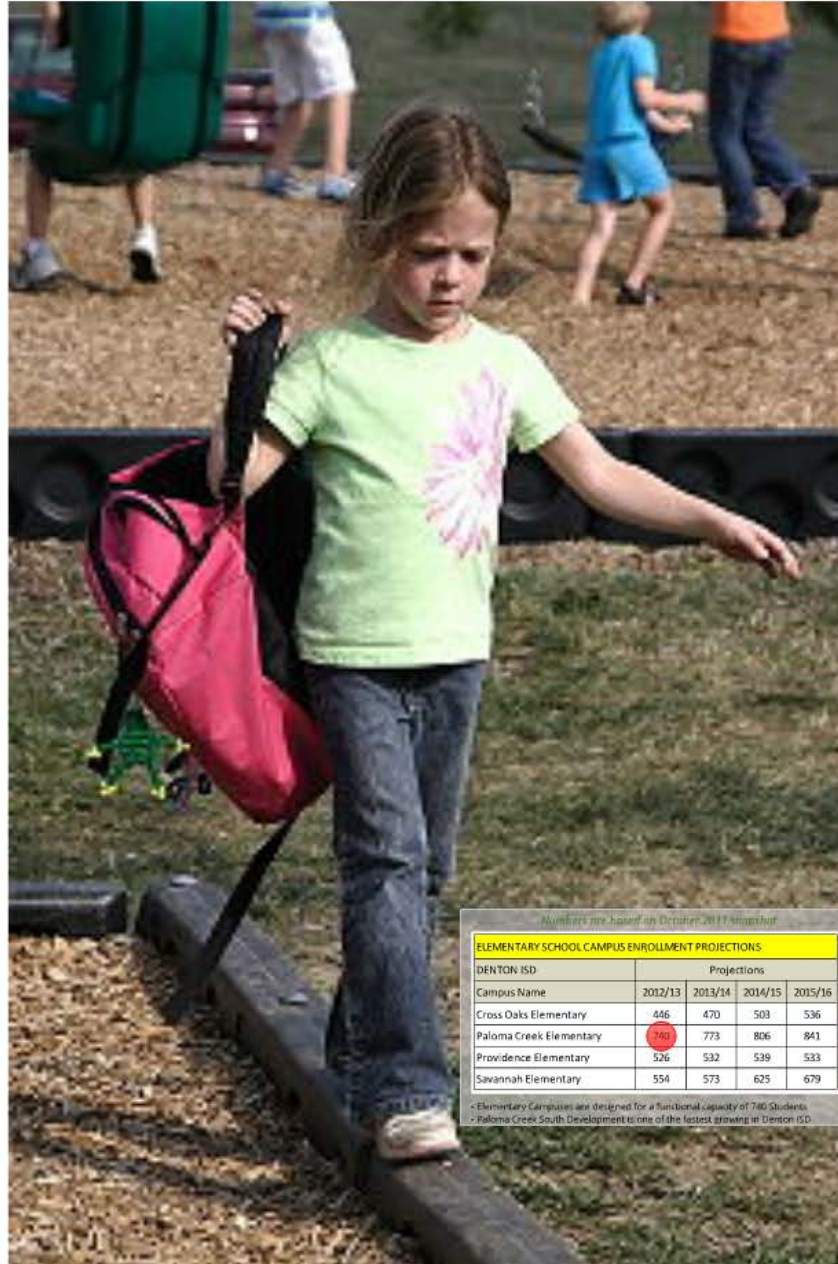

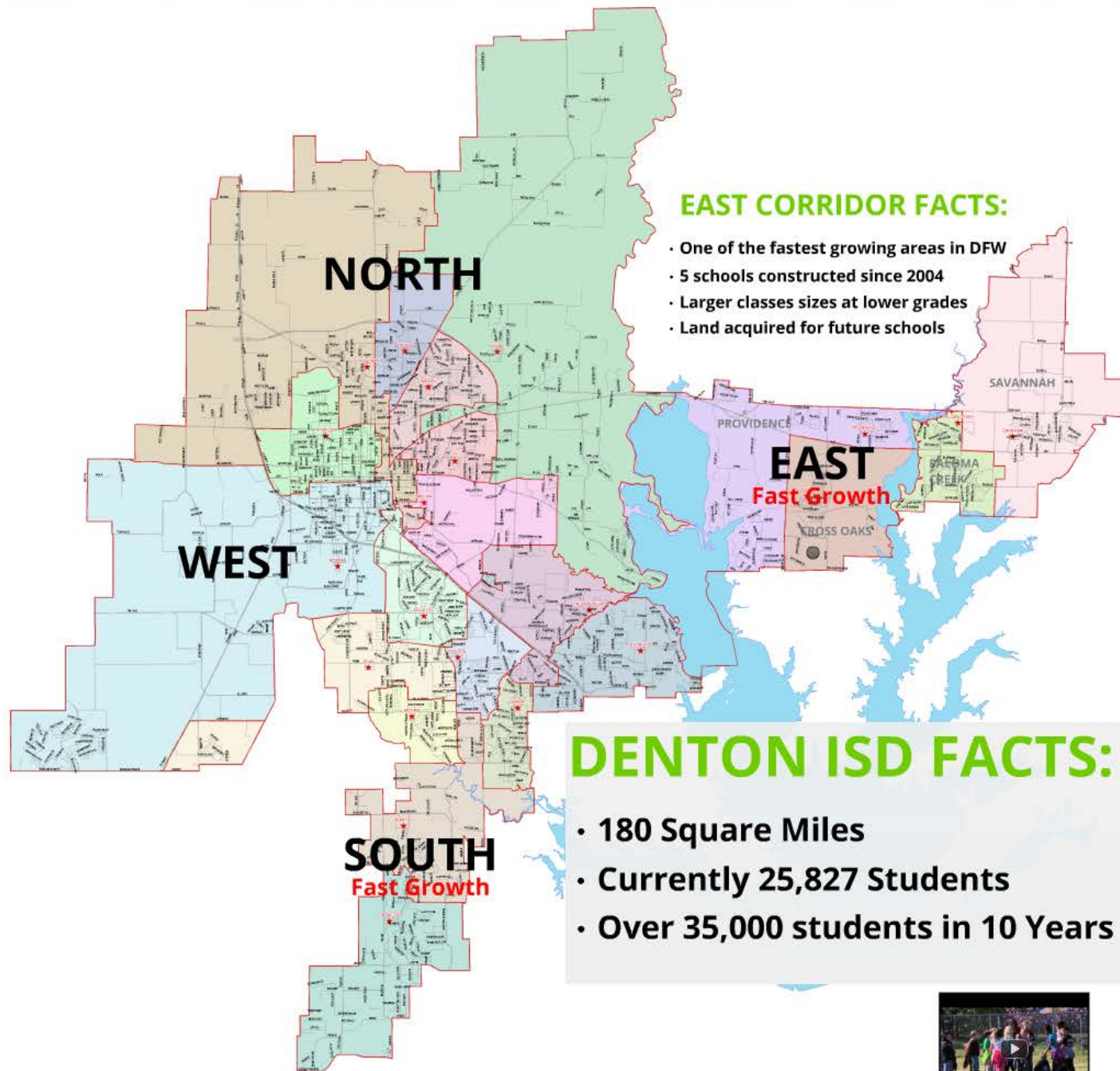

- Over 35,000 students in 10 Years



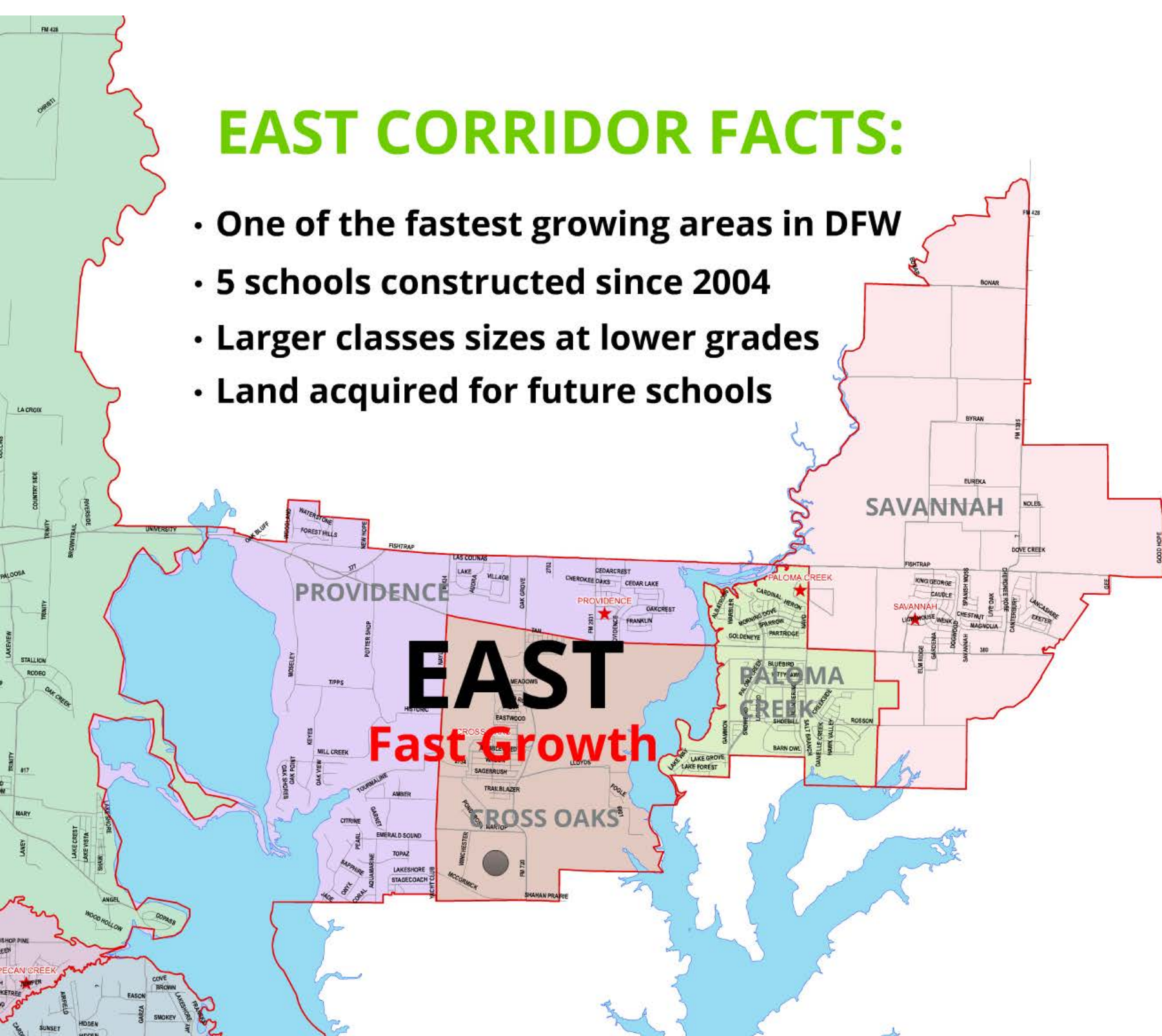

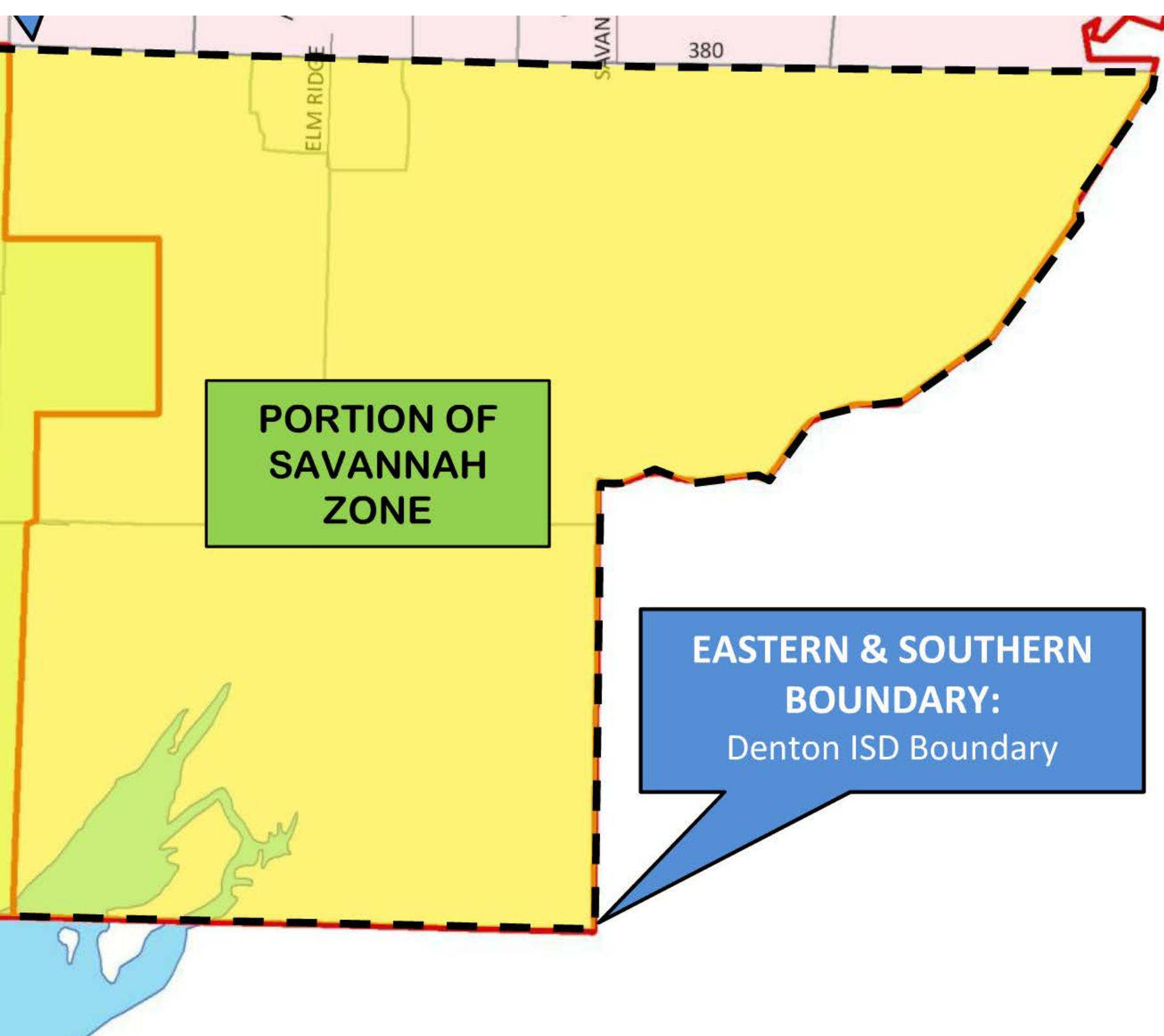

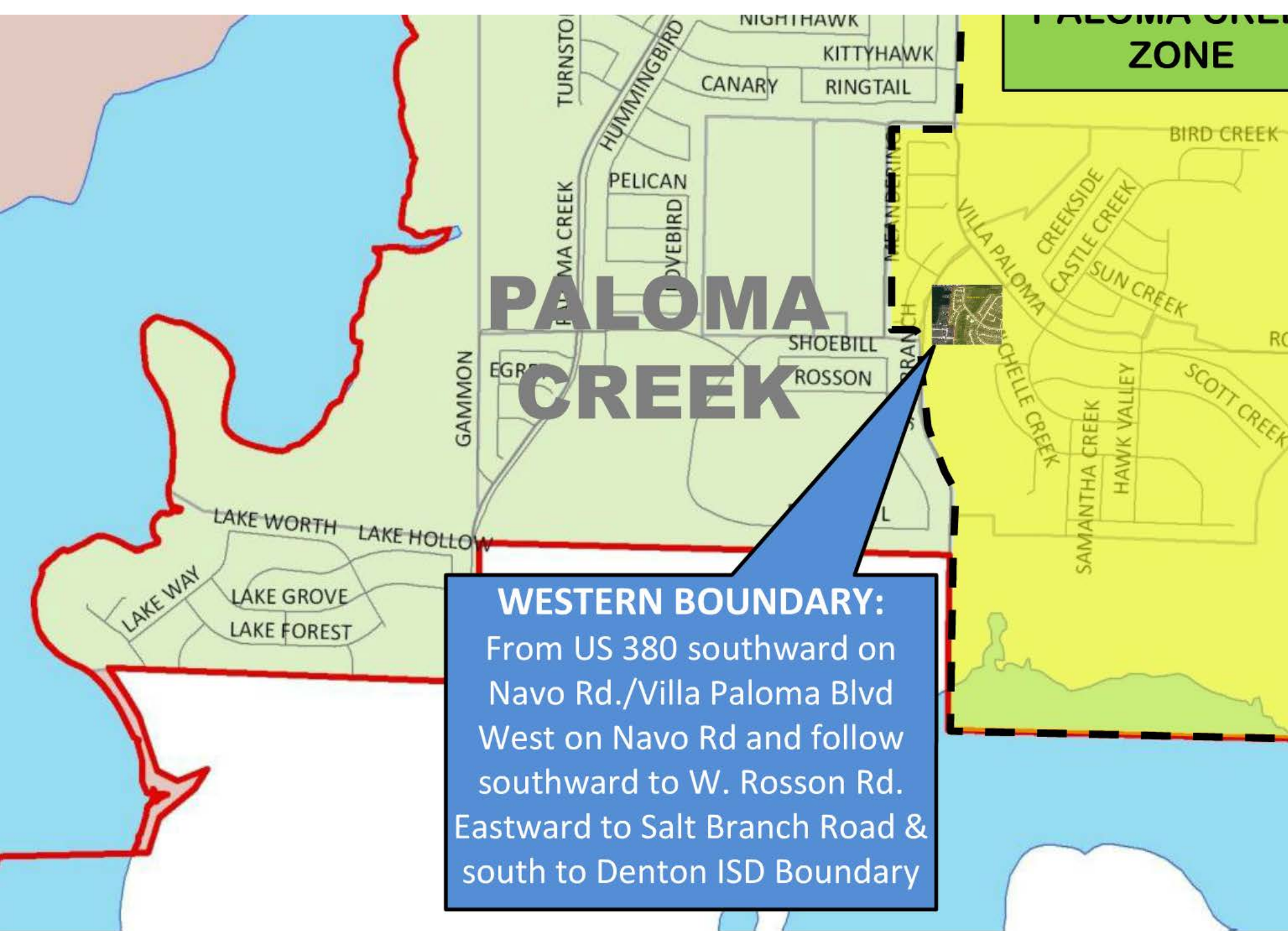

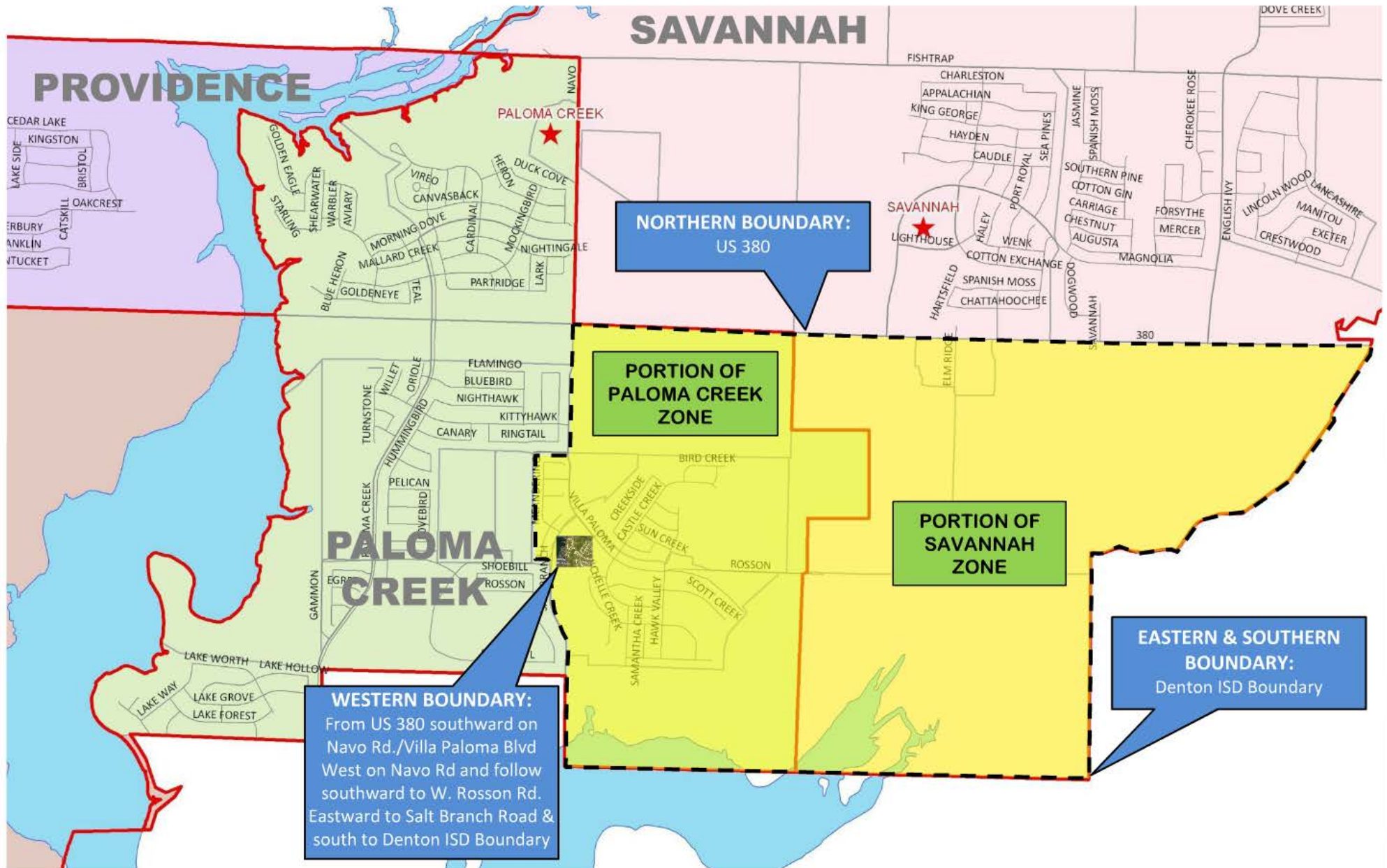

### Transfer Details

Those students that will be in 5th grade at Paloma Creek ES next year (6th 2-14 school year), and are to be assigned to Providence ES, will have the option to stay and finish along with any sibling, if attending at the same time - provided they are the following:

- 1) Students will need to go through the standard Transfer Request Process  
Elementary School In-District Transfers: Contact desired elementary campus
- 2) Parents and/or Guardians will need to provide transportation

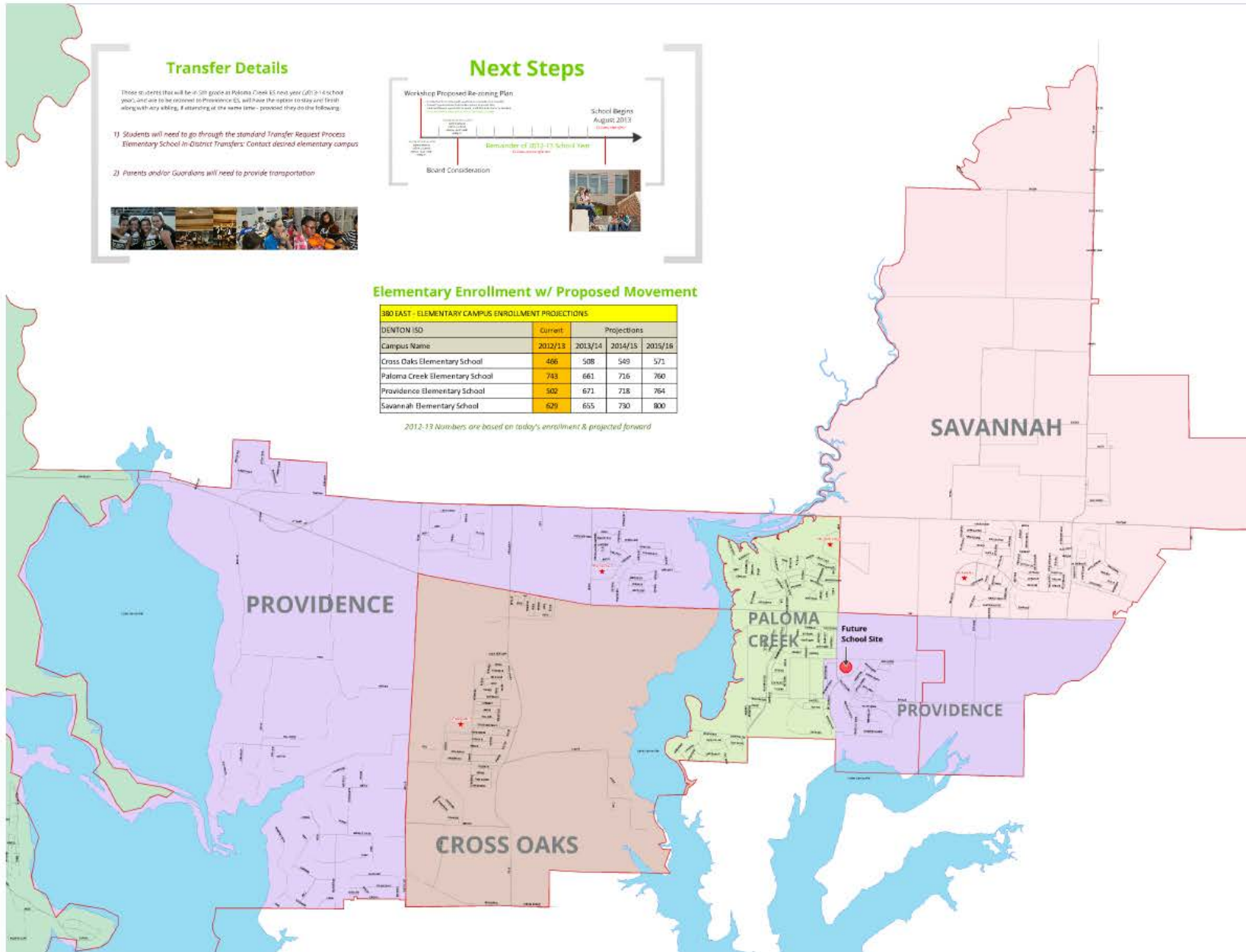

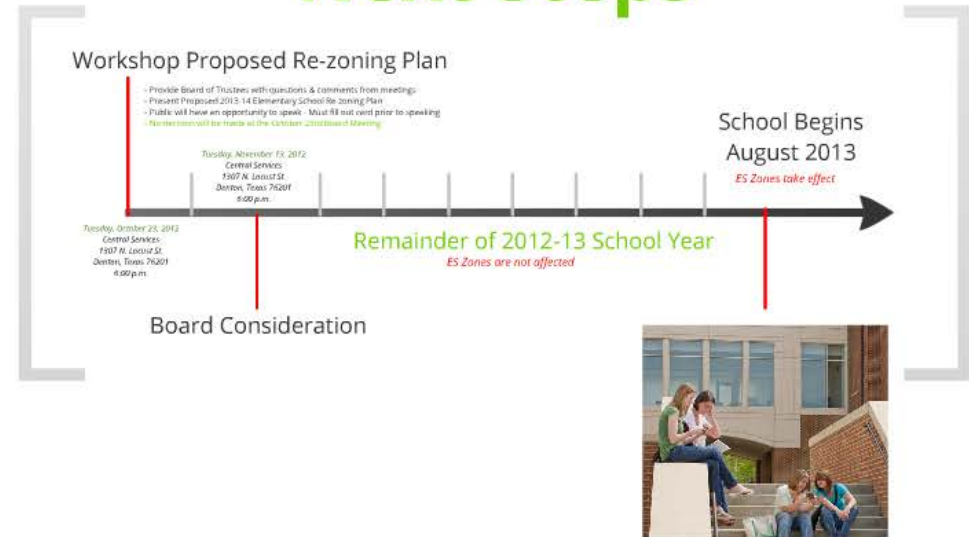
