Curriculum Guide Proposal

The Curriculum Committee met on October 8th to review changes for the 2026-2027 curriculum guide. At that meeting MCHS Department Chairs shared the proposed changes with the Curriculum Committee members present. With the new construction of the CTE wing at Central Campus, there were several new courses proposed in Industrial Tech that will be available for students in the fall. Course descriptions were updated for multiple departments, including Math, Physical Education, World Language and Fine Arts. There were also courses to be archived due to low enrollment or similar courses available.

On Wednesday October 8th we administered the PreACT exam to all Juniors, Sophomores, and Freshman. Teachers and testing coordinators did a great job making adjustments and helping students to successfully complete their exams. Curriculum Revision and Alignment Work

Currently our Science, Math, and English teams are working on revisions and alignment of their curriculum. This will complete the fourth year of English curriculum revisions and alignment.
