Food Service Building Report

The food service program is getting ready for the close of the school year and the start to the summer food program. The summer food service program will begin June 10th through August 8th. The summer program will feed breakfast, lunch, and supper Monday-Thursday. On Fridays, there will be no meals. On Thursdays, the children will receive a *meal bag* at the supper program which will be their meal for Fridays.

The summer food service program will be serving breakfast and lunch from the Middle School and Browning Elementary kitchens. We will also have a site at the skate park that will serve lunch only. And, we will also have the mobile bus that will serve lunch only to low rent, old low rent, and Starr School site. The supper program will eventually go from the Napi kitchen to Vina (bullshoe) kitchen.

Food service has (2) vacancies for hire; (1) vacancy at the supper program for an assistant cook, (1) assistant at High school, and (1) vacancy at Browning Elementary, and (1) flex cook at this time. High School had (1) resignation, BES had a new hire decline an assistant cook position, and (1) flex cook position that has not been filled since the beginning of the school year.

The Ware house has been working very hard daily to carry out their daily operations including the assistance they provide for the school kitchens, food deliveries, and mail.

The copy center has received the new RISO (2005-2024). At this time, copy center is finishing end of the school year orders and preparing for the summer season.

There is a need for some maintenance work and equipment for the Napi kitchen. The Napi kitchen is in vital need of a steam table/warmer and a salad bar server. It has been a challenge to keep the food at required temperature at all meals. At this time, I am waiting on a quote from the equipment company. The KW kitchen may also need some new equipment as well. The convection oven is not working as it should, the oven will turn on somedays and other days it does not turn on.

Attached are the reimbursements for the food service program for the month of April and the number count of each meal for April. Also attached is the pictures of the Napi kitchen steam table and the new proposed equipment.
