## I. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- A. <u>KC Ready 4s Sandra Standish:</u> Mrs. Standish stated that KC Ready Rs just completed its first year of the program, Proven benefits include increased graduation rate, reduced crime, increased adult earning, and increased property values. They anticipate serving 1250 children at full implementation.
- B. <u>Board Meeting Dates for the 2012-2013 School Year:</u> Supt. Glaes referred to the listing of meeting dates scheduled for the 2012-2013 school year. Meetings will be held on the second Monday of the month with the exception of April 15.
- C. <u>Legislative Update:</u> A state budget has been passed, but we are still waiting for MPSERS reform to be settled. We expect to see an increase of approximately \$70/student in best practice money, which is still a decrease from two years ago.
- D. <u>Staffing Update:</u> Supt. Glaes stated that this report will come monthly from Christine Veld's office. The positions that have been filled will create other openings.

## II. REPORTS AND PUBLIC INQUIRY

# A. <u>Financial Report</u> - Steve Goss

1. <u>June Budget Progress Report: Revenue:</u> Asst. Supt. Goss reviewed the budget progress report for May, 2012 showing total revenues of \$16,016,449; total expenditures of \$17,362,027; and deficiency of revenues over expenditures of -\$1,345,578.

2. Resolutions to Amend the 2011-12 Budgets and Adopt the 2012-13

Budgets for the Following Funds: General Fund, School Service Funds,

Debt Retirement Funds, and Building and Site Fund: The net effect of the

June amendment is to reduce the projected budget shortfall from \$405,000
to \$313,000, which will result in fund balance of \$2.47 million as of June
30, 2012.

Asst. Supt. Goss stated that the tax rate will be increased from 4.57 to 5.35 mills on the '91 bond. This change is due to the fact that property values have declined. In 2005 the rate was 5.5 mills.

Priorities for 2012-2013 include: 1) enhancing revenues and trimming expenditures in order to address the ongoing structural budget deficit and 2) addressing capital needs financing for ongoing facility needs, technology upgrades, and transportation

- B. 8:55 pm ANNUAL PUBLIC HEARING to Consider the District's 2012-13 Budgets and Proposed Property Tax Millage Rate: Board Member Callen asked for clarification on student enrollment and MPSERS. Mr. Goss responded that most districts are using the same assumption of a flat retirement rate. Mr. Goss consults with an enrollment trend specialist. Our approach is to be reasonably conservative. The 60 students enrolled in the WAY program are outside of the high school count. There being no further discussion, the public hearing was closed at 9:10 pm.
- C. <u>Food Service Update Maureen Ouvry:</u> Mrs. Ouvry reported that the District received approval Friday to run summer feeding program at Sunset Lake Elementary and at Portage Terrace.
