#### Free School Lunches

As you may have heard, Governor Walz recently signed a law that will provide free school breakfasts and lunches for all Minnesota students at school participating in the federal school lunch program. Our Lower School currently utilizes the federal school lunch program, however, our Upper School does not. We are taking steps to transition our Upper School to the federal program so that all students can have access to the free meals.

Another impact of this law that we will need to carefully monitor is the capacity of our food service facilities. If the free lunches result in a drastic increase in the number of students who are eating school lunches, we will be pushed beyond what our kitchen was designed to do. Charter schools do not have a mechanism to levy for facilities like traditional public schools do so we may need to look at other options should this become an issue.
