MN Statute 465.03 (Gifts to Municipalities) states:

"Any city, county, school district or town may accept a grant or devise of real or personal property and maintain such property for the benefit of its citizens in accordance with the terms prescribed by the donor. Nothing herein shall authorize such acceptance or use for religious or sectarian purposes. Every such acceptance shall be by resolution of the governing body adopted by a two-thirds majority of its members, expressing such terms in full."

THEREFORE, The Director of Grants and Special Projects recommends the following resolution:

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of Independent School District No. 622 that the school board accepts the following grants, any awarded funds, and permits their use as designated by the awarding documents.

Washington County

1. School Waste Reduction and Recycling Grant

Amount: approximately \$103,000

Purpose: Washington County provides resources and technical assistance for creating, implementing and improving programs to increase waste reduction and recycling efforts. The technical assistance, grants, equipment and supplies provided will be linked to implementation of best practices along the School Waste Reduction and Recycling Best Practices Continuum.
