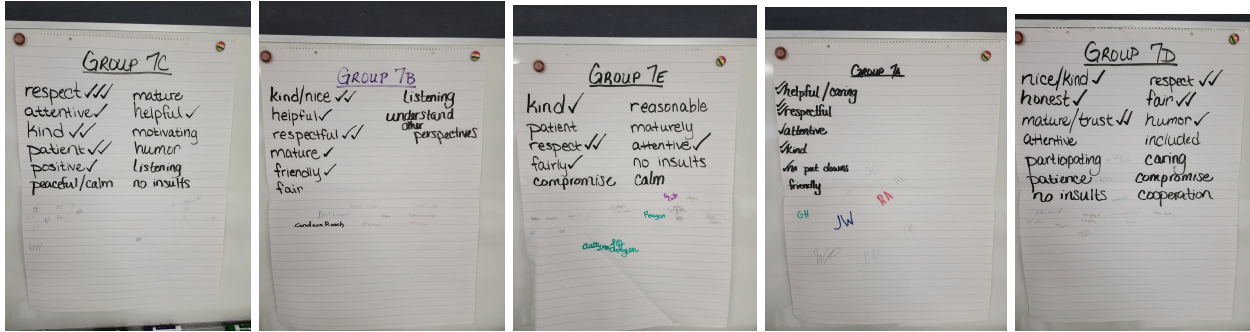
- As of 9/23, we were still collecting responses from remote learning families concerning returning to in-person instruction.

- “A LOT! One on one time with the remote learners was extremely beneficial. There’s just a natural disconnect to overcome with the RLs and the Wednesday time will help us overcome it.”
