Bond 2023

Reconfiguration

- Minimizing the number of campus transitions
- Creating an Early Learning Academy for 3-year-olds
- Elementary Schools will include grades PK4 - 5th
- Middle Schools will include grades 6th-8th

Bond 2023

Rezoning

- Rezoning into feeder patterns to Duncanville HS
- Supporting instructional, fiscal, and operational efficiencies

Brandenburg Elementary

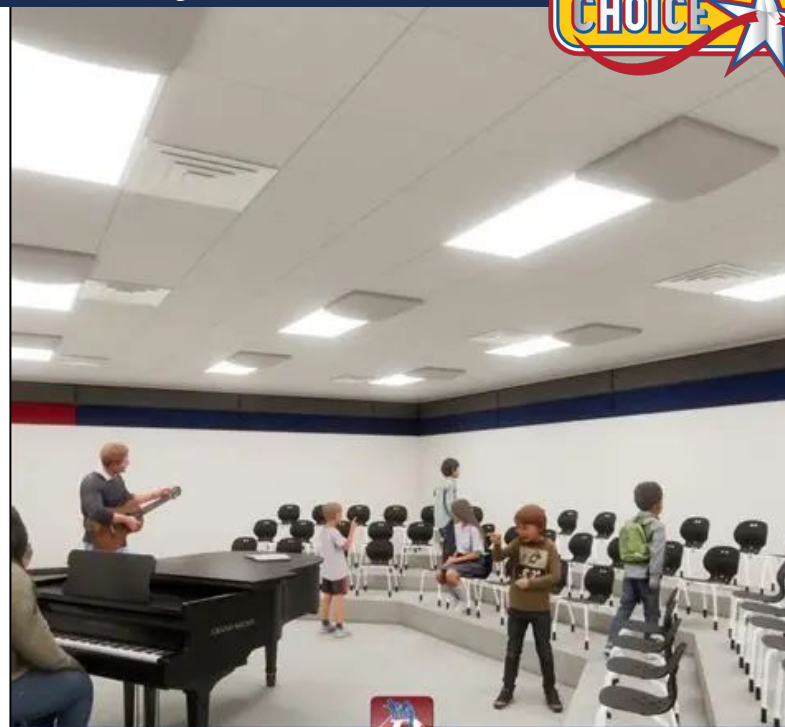


- Rezone all students from Merrifield Elementary to Brandenburg
- Building will be renovated and updated to serve elementary students
- Reopens a school in the fastest growing area of the district - (2025 *Demographic Report*)
- Signature Program- Collegiate Academy
* *Future Choice School*

Central Fine Arts Academy



- K-8th grade campus opening in 2026 - 27 as a K-5th grade campus adding a grade level each year
- Building will be renovated and updated with a Fine Arts theme
- School is by application only with no attendance zone
- Transportation will be provided for all in-district students

COMING TO DUNCANVILLE ISD IN 2026

Merrifield Education Complex (MEC)



- Will house both Alternative Campuses
 - **Mary E. Smithey PACE H.S.*
 - **Summit DAEP*
- Optimize staffing through campus consolidation
- Students will have access to a full cafeteria and gym
- Renovations will include separate wings and separate entrances for each school.



Duncanville ISD Community Support Hub



One-stop district and community hub, centralizing enrollment, student supports, and wraparound services to improve family experience, access, and operational efficiency. This facility will open January 2027.

District Enrollment Center

- Student registration and records
- Residency verification and transfers
- PEIMS-aligned data accuracy and compliance

Family & Community Supports

- Food Pantry with built-in storage
- Clothing Closet

Specialized District Services

- SPED intake and coordination
- Bilingual/ESL services
- Counseling and family engagement support



Future School-Based Health Clinic (SBHC)

- Preventative care and mental health services
- Reduced absenteeism and barriers to learning
- Partnerships with county and regional health providers

Implementation Timeline



January 2026

- Meet with **all impacted staff** at affected campuses
- Initial communication outlining rationale, vision, and next steps presented to the Board
- Hold **naming committee meeting** January 21, 2026 at the Education Plaza

February 2026

- **Community meetings** planned for neighborhoods surrounding impacted schools (Feb. 4 at Merrifield & Feb. 10 at TLC 5:30 p.m.)
- Rezoning boundaries
- Facility usage assignments
- Program placement (*Community Center, Virtual School, Alternative Campus*)
- Present finalized plan for **Board approval at February 16, 2026 meeting**
- Mail formal notification letters to all impacted students and families

March 2026

- Launch districtwide communication campaign (website, FAQs, town halls)
- Begin the staffing process with campuses for 26-27
