- A. Active member's nomination and the candidate's willingness to serve (The individual must have at least 18 months of local board service as of December 31, 2024, to be an eligible candidate.)

The completed materials must be received in the TASB Austin office no later than Wednesday, November 15, 2023. Nominations that do not meet the deadline cannot be accepted.
