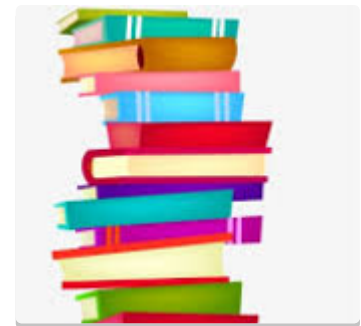

Times: 9:00 AM - 3:00 PM

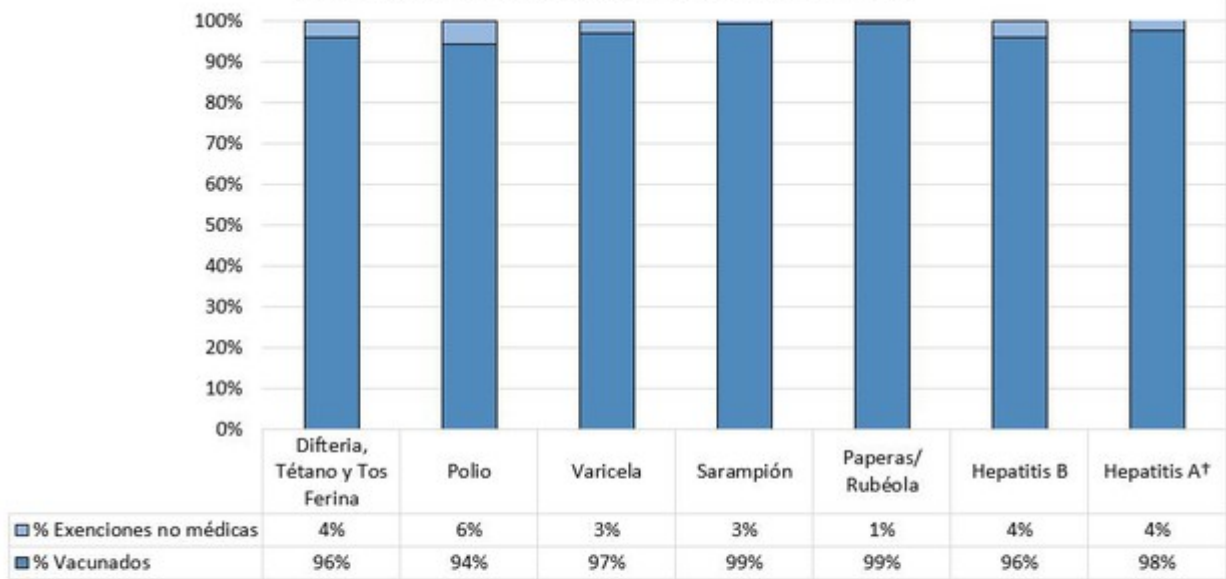

We would like to extend a special invitation to our summer enrichment program to you. This is a great opportunity to meet some of your teachers and classmates and become comfortable with navigating your new school building.

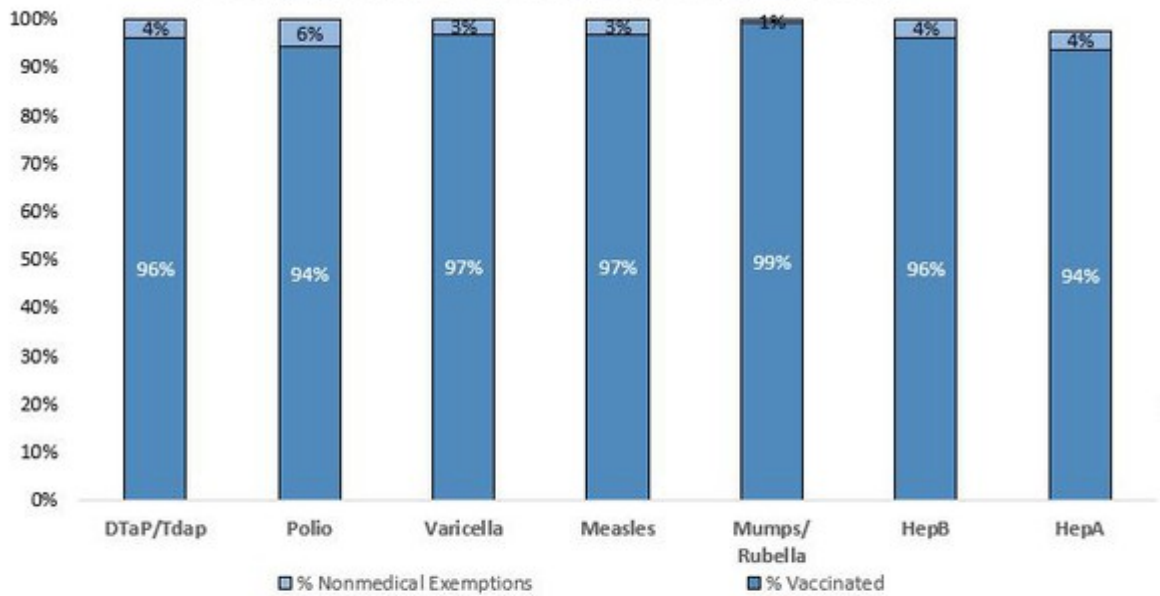
