- The Pathways Pulled Pork Fundraiser and Silent Auction raised \$7,418 for the Pathways Scholarship Program in Perryton. We continue to see a good turnout at this event each year!
- FPC distributed t-shirts to 68 Pathways-eligible PHS graduating seniors.
- We are happy to be offering a Microsoft Applications class on campus with Denisse Breshears. This community education class has nine students enrolled and will cover Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Access.
- We have purchased a 2017 International truck and a 1998 Wilson Grain Hopper under the TRUE grant. This additional equipment will help serve the ELDT/CDL students in Perryton.

 - e. 8 students will receive their LVN certificate
 - f. 27 Students will receive their certificate in Cosmetology (6 of those are dual credit graduates)
