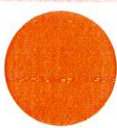

NEW INITIATIVES FOR SUMMER PROGRAM

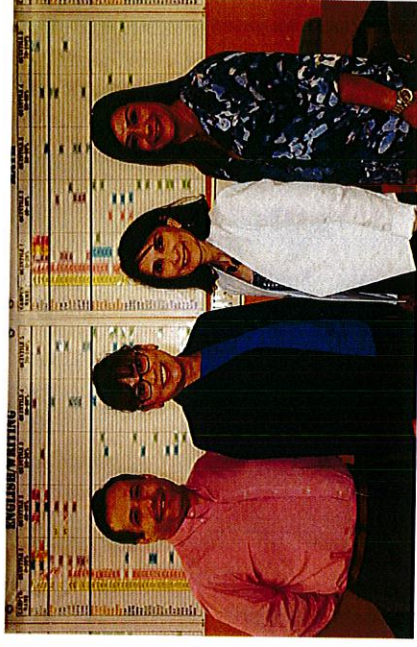
- Summer Academy with 2019 cohort at LBJ H.S.

- Implemented a full core curriculum with all ESY classes.



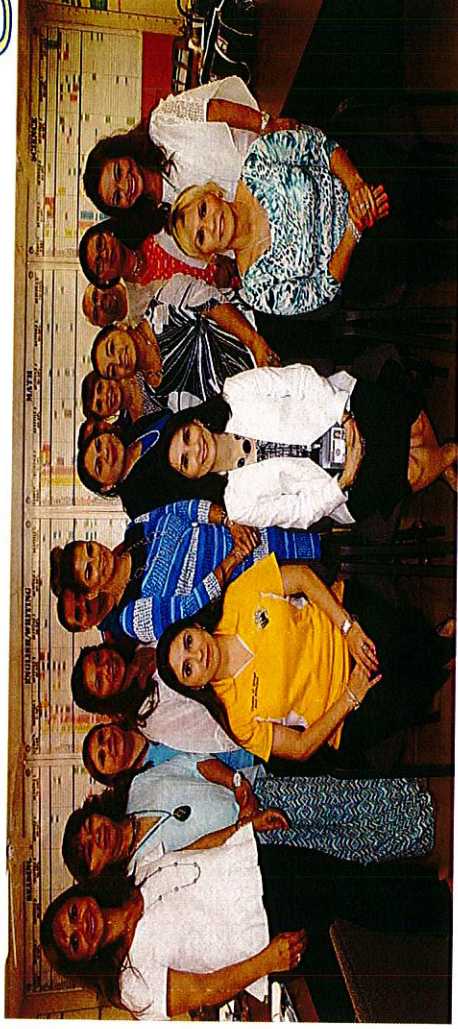
