Much of school board work includes legal issues, directly or indirectly, and navigating the legal landscape can be challenging. The IASB Office of General Counsel (OGC) is staffed with three attorneys who advise the Association, draft sample policies and procedures for the Policy Reference Education Subscription Service (PRESS), and contribute to many IASB programs and publications. Although the OGC does not provide legal advice to school boards, they provide a wealth of legal information and legal resources to IASB members. Join us as Assistant General Counsel Maryam Brotine, armed with both her private sector experience advising school boards and her OGC experience, addresses current legal hot topics within recently released PRESS Issue 100, including targeted school violence prevention and threat assessment, as well as other legal issues looming on the horizon.

Breakout Session: Briefing for Candidates

This session is designed to provide **board candidates** with an overview of the roles and responsibilities of an elected school board member and an idea of what to expect if they are successful in the April elections.
