We are looking forward to sharing that information and using it to guide instructional decisions moving forward.

Our annual Food Drive was a great success. Pizza was delivered to Mrs. Butler's class, the winning Food Drive Donors at PLE. Thank you to the PTO for sponsoring the winning class and helping make the event fun and engaging for students while supporting a great cause.

In another exciting community event, Mrs. Gilbert's 4th grade class took first place in a gingerbread house decorating contest and raised over \$2,000 for the Priest Lake Education Foundation. This was an outstanding effort by our students and families and a great example of how PLE continues to support and give back to the local community.

Looking ahead, Missoula Children's Theater will be returning to PLE in March to produce Alice in Wonderland. This is always a highlight for our students and provides a unique opportunity for them to experience live theater and performance.
