

# UIL Waivable Courses 2005-2006

By State Board of Education/TEA/UIL

1. English Language Arts: All College Board advanced placement courses and International Baccalaureate courses in the discipline, and high school/college concurrent enrollment classes that are included in the "Lower-Division Academic Course Guide Manual."
2. Fine Arts: All College Board advanced placement courses and International Baccalaureate courses in the discipline, high school/college concurrent enrollment classes that are included in the "Lower-Division Academic Course Guide Manual," Art IV, Dance IV (not to include drill team activities), Music IV, and Theatre IV.
3. Languages Other Than English: All College Board advanced placement courses and International Baccalaureate courses in the discipline, high school/college concurrent enrollment classes that are included in the "Lower-Division Academic Course Guide Manual," and languages other than English courses Levels IV-VII.
4. Mathematics: All College Board advanced placement courses and International Baccalaureate courses in the discipline, high school/college concurrent enrollment classes that are included in the "Lower-Division Academic Course Guide Manual" and Precalculus.
5. Science: All College Board advanced placement courses and International Baccalaureate courses in the discipline, high school/college concurrent enrollment classes that are included in the "Lower-Division Academic Course Guide Manual."
6. Social Studies: Social Studies Advanced Studies, Economics Advanced Studies, all College Board advanced placement courses and International Baccalaureate courses in the discipline, and high school/college concurrent enrollment classes that are included in the "Lower-Division Academic Course Guide Manual."

In addition to the courses listed above and identified by TEA as waivable courses for extracurricular eligibility, we recommend for exemption waiver the additional courses.
