Re: Purchase of Hydration Stations

I would like to discuss, at the February 10, 2025, Committee of the Whole Meeting, the purchase of 40 hydration stations for various buildings in the district. This will help us meet the state requirements of the Filter First program, which requires schools and childcare centers to develop a drinking water management plan, including installing filters in bottle filler (i.e. – hydration stations) that reduce lead levels in all drinking water fixtures. Ferguson Facilities Supply is the company providing the hydration stations via pricing from the OMNIA Partners contract.

The total cost for this purchase is \$61,776. The funding source for this purchase will be the Filter First Grant.
