As a part of Lee College's commitment to recruiting first-time students, qualifying students can attend the Fall or Spring term with no out-of-pocket cost for tuition, fees, and textbooks. In particular, the costs for the following student groups will be paid by student financial aid or institutional funds:

In order to qualify, Lee College Regular Enrollment students must:

- 1) Reside in the Lee College service district; AND
- 2) Not have attended Lee College since finishing high school or getting a GED; AND
- 3) Have completed the FAFSA or TAFSA if they are eligible; AND
- 4) Meet other requirements as determined by the President to meet the intent of this resolution.
