

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COMBINED POLLING PLACES  
FOR SCHOOL DISTRICT ELECTIONS NOT HELD  
ON THE DAY OF A STATEWIDE ELECTION**

BE IT RESOLVED by the School Board of [jurisdiction], State of Minnesota, as follows:

1. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the precincts and polling places for school district elections are those precincts or parts of precincts located within the boundaries of the school district which have been established by the cities or towns located in whole or in part within the school district. The board hereby confirms those precincts and polling places so established by those municipalities.

2. Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes, Section 205A.11, the board may establish a combined polling place for several precincts for school elections not held on the day of a statewide election. The combined polling places are established to serve the precincts specified for all school district special and general elections not held on the same day as a statewide election. Those combined polling places are listed below:

COMBINED POLLING PLACE: Precinct No. 1 - Buffalo  
Buffalo Community Middle School, 1300 Hwy. 25 N., Buffalo, MN 55313

This combined polling place serves all territory in Independent School District No. 877 located in the City of Buffalo, Precincts 1, 2, 3 and 4 ; and Maple Lake, Monticello, Buffalo, Chatham and Rockford Townships; Wright County, Minnesota.

COMBINED POLLING PLACE: Precinct No. 2 - Montrose  
Montrose Elementary School, 100 S.E. Second Street, Montrose, MN 55363

This combined polling place serves all territory in Independent School District No. 877 located in the City of Montrose; and Marysville, Woodland and Franklin Townships; Wright County, Minnesota.

COMBINED POLLING PLACE: Precinct No. 3 - Hanover  
Hanover Elementary School, Highway 19, Hanover, MN 55341

This combined polling place serves all territory in Independent School District No. 877 located in the Cities of Hanover and St. Michael; and Frankfort Township; Wright County; and the Cities of Hanover, Greenfield, Corcoran and Rogers; Hennepin County, Minnesota.
