Early Entrance**

A student is considered six years of age and will be admitted into the first grade a public school if his/her sixth birthday occurs on or before September 1, as established by law. In addition, aA student whose sixth birthday occurs after that date may be admitted to the first grade if he/she: has maintained regular attendance in any grade of a public full-time school during the entire school term.

1. Is a first grade student transferring from a public school in another district, or from a private school;

2. Completed a successful year in a public kindergarten the previous year and would be continuing his/her formal education.

A student will be admitted to kindergarten if his/her fifth birthday occurs one year earlier than the date established by law for entry into first grade, on or before September 1, or is a kindergarten student transferring from a public school in another district.

Early entry into school willmay be allowed for a student whose fifth/sixth birthday occurs after September 1, but not later than November 15 and whose needs would best be met in the school program based on an analysis by qualified professional staff of his/her:

- 1. Cognitive development;
- 2. Social development;
- 3. Physical development.

The superintendent shall identify screening processes and instruments which will provide a dependable assessment of the preceding criteria.

Parents will be required to pay the cost of the special testing involved.
