Preschool Student Placement

Preschool placements will be worked through in the coming weeks. When assigning students, we prioritize parent/guardian preferences, recognizing that families often select schedules that work best for their own needs. During enrollment, parents/guardians indicate their 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choice options. We strive to accommodate the 1st and 2nd choices whenever possible. Additionally, placements are balanced based on factors such as class size, gender ratio, age, care needs, and behavioral and learning requirements. As usual, new registrations will be accepted until the start of the school year.
