Background:

Since 2023, the City of West Allis has annually requested to host its 4th of July Fireworks Event at the West Allis Athletic Complex. In 2023 and 2024, the Board of Education approved the request. The location has proven to be well received by the community, guests, and city officials that the City of West Allis is requesting use of the West Allis Athletic Complex for their 2025 4th of July Fireworks display.

The City of West Allis is required to hold a single day certificate of insurance as the host of the event.

Tailgating and picnicking will be permitted and we anticipate members of the public will enjoy alcoholic beverages as part of the event. Because of this tradition, we are asking the Board of Education to temporarily waive policies that prohibit alcohol on school grounds and to temporarily waive the policy that prohibits the use of tobacco and nicotine on school grounds.

The West Allis Police Department will be on premises during the event and will respond to any member of the public who over indulges in alcoholic beverages.

Purpose:

The annual City of West Allis fireworks event has not banned the consumption of alcohol during the annual fireworks event in the past, and that the School District of West Allis-West Milwaukee et. al., bans the possession of alcohol and use of tobacco and nicotine on school district property as stated in Board Policies; 3122.01 and 4122.01 - Drug-Free Workplace, Board Policy 7434 - Use of Tobacco and Nicotine on School Premises, and Board Rule 830 Rule-2 - Facility Usage Policy and Procedures. These board policies will need to be temporarily waived by the Board of Education in order to provide for a July 4th celebration consistent with past practice and approve the City of West Allis facility usage request.

Recommendation(s):

Administration recommends temporarily waiving Board Policies 3122.01 and 4122.01 - Drug-Free Workplace and Board Policy 7434 - Use of Tobacco and Nicotine on School Premises, and Board Rule 830 Rule-2 - Facility Usage Policy and Procedures, for the dates of July 4, 2025, and July 5, 2025 (rain date) on the West Allis Athletic Complex and Nathan Hale High School Grounds. Administration further recommends the board consider adopting policy in the future to approve this specific request, activity and purpose on an annual basis.
