

CELINA ISD BOARD REGULATIONS GOVERNING SCHOOL MARSHALS

The purpose of these regulations is to meet the requirements of CKE
(LEGAL)

1. A Celina ISD school marshal must adhere and operate in accordance with Texas Education Code Sec. 37.0811. A Celina ISD school marshal may make arrests and exercise all authority given to peace officers under Section 2, Chapter 2, Article 2.127, Code of Criminal Procedure, but only to the extent necessary to prevent or abate the commission of an offense that threatens serious bodily injury or death of students, faculty, or visitors on school premises, provided, however, a Celina ISD school marshal may not issue a traffic citation for a violation of Chapter 521, Transportation Code, or Subtitle C, Title 7 Transportation Code. A Celina ISD school marshal may access a handgun only under circumstances that would justify the use of deadly force under Section 9.32 or 9.33 of the Penal Code.
2. A Celina ISD school marshal may only carry an approved handgun (a) in compliance with the legal requirements for a licensed concealed handgun carrier and (b) as may be determined by the Board at any Celina ISD campuses or properties whether leased or owned. A Celina ISD school marshal may carry an approved handgun on the physical premises of all district campuses, if authorized by the Board.
3. A Celina ISD school marshal must use commercially produced holsters that provide adequate retention to secure the firearm. No firearms may be allowed to be kept in purses, handbags, backpacks, or an unsecured accessory. If a Celina ISD school marshal's primary duty involves regular, direct contact with students, the marshal shall not carry a concealed handgun but may possess an approved handgun on the physical premises of a school in a locked, secure gun safe within the marshal's immediate reach when conducting the marshal's primary duty.
4. Any approved handgun carried by or within access of a Celina ISD school marshal must be loaded only with frangible ammunition designed to disintegrate on impact for maximum safety and minimal danger to others as approved by TCOLE. Such frangible ammunition must be approved by the Board.
5. A Celina ISD school marshal's status as a "school marshal" becomes inactive on:

- a. Expiration of the employee's school marshal license under Occupations Code 1701.260.
 - b. Suspension or revocation of the employees concealed handgun license.
 - c. Termination of the employee's employment or being placed on administrative leave with Celina ISD.
 - d. Notice from the Board that the employee's services as school marshal are no longer required.
 - e. Failure to demonstrate weapons proficiency to the satisfaction of the Celina ISD Police Department firearms training staff.
 - f. Violation of any Celina ISD policy or regulation applicable to a Celina ISD school marshal.
6. A Celina ISD school marshal will be responsible for providing his own duty handgun and holster which must be approved by the Celina ISD Police Department. Each duty handgun must meet all of the following requirements:
- a. The Celina ISD Police Department will maintain a record of any handgun a Celina ISD school marshal is authorized to carry.
 - b. A Celina ISD school marshal's handguns must be listed on the Celina ISD Police Department's approved firearm list.
 - c. All duty handguns to be carried by a Celina ISD school marshal must be registered with the Celina ISD Police Department by the marshal requesting to carry them.
 - d. Celina ISD will provide weapons qualification annually for one duty handgun. If a Celina ISD school marshal request qualification on more than one duty handgun annually, the participant will be required to provide for the extra qualification by a Certified TCOLE Firearms Instructor.
 - e. A Celina ISD school marshal must deliver all duty handguns to the Celina ISD Police Department one time per year for inspection and registration by the Celina ISD Police Department firearms training staff. Each of a marshal's duty handguns will undergo a thorough inspection and will be test fired and evaluated for reliability and examined to see if it conforms to existing safety standards. Handguns that do not pass the safety inspection may not be used by a Celina ISD school marshal. Handguns may not be modified in any way after this inspection and participant qualification.
 - f. A Celina ISD school marshal's list of approved duty handguns may change during the school year so long as each handgun meets the requirements hereof before it is used in service.

7. A Celina ISD school marshal must annually complete and pass the TCOLE weapons qualification course of fire at the designated Celina ISD Police Department firearms training center. A Celina ISD school marshal must qualify with all firearms that he has registered with the Celina ISD Police firearms training center. A Celina ISD school marshal must also demonstrate weapons proficiency to the satisfaction of the Celina ISD Police Department firearms instructors.

8. A Celina ISD school marshal will be required to attend all active shooter trainings provided by the Celina ISD Police and/or other local police agencies.
