WHY: It's the biggest gathering of journalists in the world, almost all of whom are high school students. Approximately 5,000 high schoolers converge in one of America's most famous cities. Students will attend numerous journalism-related sessions and come away with knowledge that will continue to make our publications among the nation's best. Attending these conventions is key to keeping our edge on what are the newest trends in the media world.
