## **Background Information**

A calendar planning committee comprised of teachers, parents, community members, students, directors, coordinators and other district leaders collaborated to develop priority needs for the 2025-2026 academic calendar. The committee had two top priorities-continue to embed professional learning opportunities into the calendar and a third, mid-week start date for students to ensure adequate time to hire and professionally develop staff.

As a result, the new academic calendar recommendation will continue to have embedded professional development days throughout the year. Sample calendars were provided to staff, parents, and students as a survey to gather feedback. The survey was posted on the district website, emailed to staff and parents and posted to the district social media platforms. The results of that feedback is provided to the board of Trustees for their consideration in the calendar approval process.
