I would like to continue our discussion regarding the purchase of new maintenance vehicles at the next Committee of the Whole meeting on Monday, July 24, 2017. We are recommending the purchase of five (5) Ford T-150 Utility Vans from Gorno Ford at a cost of \$25,220.00 each for a total of \$126,100.00. The price of these vehicles was procured from the MI-Deal State of Michigan purchasing consortium.
