INNOVATIONS:

1. Crestview Elementary has added a room this year for therapy and related needs. Eligible students use this space to receive physical and occupational therapy from our therapists. A properly mounted swing, ball-pit, mats, and other items are available to accommodates the therapy needs of each student. Additionally, I am working with staff members to transform this room into a sensory lab. A sensory lab provides students (regular or special ed) with items and objects to meet their sensory needs and calm / refocus them so they can quickly return to instruction. This affects a small number of students.


FIELD TRIPS:
