AFFILIATION AGREEMENT

This agreement is made and entered by and between Eagle Pass ISD-Transportation and SOUTHWEST TEXAS JUNIOR COLLEGE, DIESEL Program, Uvalde, Texas, hereinafter called "SWTJC- DIESEL".

WHEREAS, Eagle Pass ISD operates a Mechanic Shop at Eagle Pass TX, and

WHEREAS, SWTJC- DIESEL operates an accredited DIESEL Program, and

WHEREAS, the Parties desire to advance DIESEL education and aid in meeting the ever increasing demand in the DIESEL industry.

WHEREAS, it is deemed advised and to the best interest of the parties to establish an affiliation for the purpose of carrying out these objectives.

NOW THEREFORE, and in consideration of the foregoing and in further consideration of the mutual benefits, the Parties hereto agree as follows:

ARTICLE I
ORIGINAL TERM, RENEWAL, AND TERMINATION

The original term of the agreement starts Mar 23, 15 and shall continue in full force and effect on a year-to-year basis unless thirty (30) days written notice of intent to terminate the agreement is given by either party to the agreement.

ARTICLE II
RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE PARTIES

DIESEL Student Sponsor will:

1. Provide adequate facilities, equipment, and resources for appropriate learning experience.
2. Allow learning experience and instruction in the following services: When applicable.
 - A. Understand the job in order to be productive
 - B. To organize, plan and be neat
 - C. To be dependable such as attendance and punctuality
 - D. Safety
 - E. Use of Meters and Tools of the trade
 - F. Electrical troubleshooting
 - G. Installation procedures
 - II. Make sound decisions
 - I. To accept criticism
 - J. Working well with others
 - K. Ambition to progress and succeed

SWTJC- DIESEL Dept. will:

1. Maintain the authority and responsibility for educational DIESEL programs for its students.
2. To provide a well prepared entry level DIESEL student that's been exposed to classroom and hands on settings.
3. Provide sponsor with student evaluation forms, maintain files and all other paper work necessary for each student.
4. Provide workman's compensation Insurance for students during the term of this agreement and any extensions thereof.

ARTICLE III SEVERABILITY

If any term or provision of this agreement is held to be invalid for any reason, the invalidity of that section shall not affect the validity of any other section of this agreement provided that any invalid provision is not material to the overall purpose and operations of this agreement. The remaining provisions of this agreement shall continue in full force and effect and shall in no way be affected, impaired, or invalidated.

ARTICLE IV AMENDMENT

This agreement may be amended in writing to include any provisions that are agreed to by the contracting parties.

ARTICLE V VENUE

This agreement shall be governed by and construed and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. Venue will be in accordance with the Texas Civil Practice & Remedies Code and any amendments thereto.

ARTICLE VI ASSIGNMENT

Neither party shall have the right to assign or transfer their rights to any third parties under the agreement without the prior written consent of the other party.

ARTICLE VII INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR STATUS

Nothing in this agreement is intended nor shall be construed to create an employer/employee relationship between contracting parties. The sole interest and responsibility of the parties is to ensure that the services covered by this agreement shall be performed and rendered in a competent, efficient, and satisfactory manner.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned parties do hereby bind themselves to the faithful performance of this contract.

ARTICLE VIII
