2019 Fall Surveys

(Surveys were administered to students, parents, and staff)

Derby Middle School participation:

Parents - 128 responses

Students - 355 responses (98%)

Staff - 53 responses





Highlights



Parent Survey Highlights

- 85% of parents indicated the school community respects and embraces diversity.
- 81% indicated I am well-informed about my child's progress throughout the school year.
- 91% indicated my child's school is well-cared for and clean.
- 83% indicated the school staff encourage students at this school to respect each other's differences.
- 81% indicated the school has clear rules and expectations for student behavior
- 80% indicated the principal sets high expectations for learning at this school.



Student Survey Highlights

- 96% said my family wants me to do well in school
- 88% said my family holds me accountable for my behavior in school
- 75% said if I do not come to school, there is a teacher or other adult that will notice my absence.
- 70% said adults at my school treat students with respect
- 79% said I have friends at school who I can talk to and trust.



Staff Survey Highlights

- 90% said my principal provides me with useful and timely feedback on my practice.
- 98% said the principal communicates regularly and effectively with staff
- 91% said the principal sets a clear vision for the school.
- 97% said adults in this school really care about all the students



- 87% said student are recognized often at this school for their work/achievement (academics, attendance, behavior, etc)
- 89% said adults in this school treat students with respect.
- 88% said the school schedule allows adequate time for teacher collaboration.



Growth Areas



Parent Survey Growth Areas

- 56% of parents indicated that parents have opportunities to be involved at this school.
- 71% of parents indicated that staff at this school are available to provide extra help or support when my child needs it.
- 53% of parents indicated that my child has encountered harassment or teasing this school year.



Student Survey Growth Areas

- 41% of students said students are invited to help make decisions about what goes on in my school.
- 59% said my teachers give me a lot of encouragement.
- 22% said most students at my school treat each other well.
- 66% said my teachers really care about me and my well-being.



Staff Survey Growth Area

- 69% of staff indicated I have access to the tools I need to do my job well.
- 64% said school events are well-attended by staff.
- 68% said technology in this school is reliable.
- 60% said students at this school respect each other's differences.
- 43% said students at this school treat other students with respect.
- 68% said teachers at this school hold each other accountable for consistently maintaining school-wide expectations.
