District Goal: #2 All students are provided the opportunity to reach their full potential - be responsive to the needs of all students

**Critical Element:** Meet the physical, social, emotional and mental health needs of students while still meeting the academic needs of all students.

**Specific Goal:** During the year we will monitor progress of struggling students at each grade level and the goal is to have every student at least pass 3 of their 4 core classes with the given interventions. We will identify our struggling students through our Request for Assistance referral system and then staff these students through our Grade Level Teams. We have Grade Level meetings 1 time per month to staff students and document successful unsuccessful Tier 1 interventions.

**Current Status:** We are rebuilding existing system along with creatively creating new systems and processes to supports and meet the needs of all students at Pendleton High School

**Desired Status:** At Pendleton, we strive to graduate all students. It is also important to us that all students are college and/or career ready when they walk across the stage. A major factor in that is student success at the 9<sup>th</sup> grade level. We feel that with the relationships built and the interventions that are available that we can help all of our students.
