The North 35.00 feet of the West 60.00 feet of the East 214.73 feet and the North 30.00 feet of the East 154.73 feet of the Northeast Quarter (NE 1\4) of the Southeast Quarter (SE 1\4) of said Section 4;

Except the East 30.00 feet thereof.

- 3. Potential Land-Lease of District-Owned Real Estate Located at 400 East Wetmore Road to the Pima County Joint Technological Education District ("JTED"); Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(3) and (7).
- 4. Its Position and Instruct Its Representatives in the Meet and Confer Process Pertaining to Compensation and Benefits for Certificated, Professional Non-Teaching, Support and Administrative Staff for the 2019-2020 Fiscal Year, Pursuant to A.R.S. §38-431.03(A)(5).
