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Building Initiative- Lincoln school has started a building initiative towards improved Math Scores by implementing designated time for Response to Intervention (RtI) that we call WIN (What I Need). This time is in addition to Title I interventions that already exist. We recently had Brandon Wright, an attorney from Miller, Tracy, Braun, Funk, Miller, Ltd., share insightful information about the law and how it pertains to collecting data during interventions and the necessity of this information before referring students for special education services. This professional development helped clarify part of the "why" in what we are doing as a building towards this initiative.

In addition, we are building a schoolwide guided math system into the core curriculum block as a way for teachers to work more closely with students in small group settings and bringing application to abstract concepts using manipulatives and hands-on activities.

I have had monthly contact with her in Cohort meetings on Zoom and the Lincoln School-Process Champions Team (we call Culture Club) will also meet with her and hold their first meeting this year to later discuss a staff-morale building activity planned for Red Ribbon Week.
