Working in close collaboration with the Boys and Girls club, students are placed into the program for primarily short-term interventions. In almost all cases, students are able to successfully transition back to their home school in the regular-ed setting. The goal with placements at Boys and Girls Club is to provide a short-term intervention with students BEFORE their behavior becomes so severe that multiple suspensions or an expulsion become necessary. The 10 "slots" will be available to all middle schools. The principals will work together to determine how to maximize the use of the "slots".
