

Contract Approval for Security Features

Security Gates and Fencing Scope of Work:

Purpose: Secure campuses with preventing vehicle traffic behind schools

3 Power Sliding gates with keypad/remote entry:

- Primary entrance by baseball field (6 ft with wrought iron fencing to school and up the hill to baseball fencing. Includes padlock passing gate.
- Middle School entrance at back of school (6 ft with wrought iron fencing) Includes key lock passing gate.
- Field House entrance (6 ft with galvanized black chain link fencing - like baseball field)

2 Power Swinging gates with keypad/remote entry:

- Elementary School road next to DAEP building (4 ft with galvanized chain link fencing)
- Stadium entrance at bottom of stands on home side up to high school (6 ft with galvanized chain link fencing)

Gate Access Control: \$2,800 United Security Services

- Card readers only at Middle School drive to AG barn
- Remaining gates will utilize fob / clicker

Precision Fencing Quote including electrical expense

- \$70,335 to include galvanized by field house
- \$71,145 to include black galvanized by field house
- Quote includes 15 clickers

Phillips Entry Services Quote including electrical expense

- \$77,204 to include galvanized by field house
- \$78,388 to include black galvanized by field house

Proposed Approval: Precision Fencing for \$71,145 and gate access control \$2,800

Access Control & Video Monitoring at Main Entrances / HS buildings:

Purpose: Secure the campus with locked doors and allow capability to grant access

Approved Devices at January Board Meeting - Contract awarded to Sword
