Here are some important school announcements:

Masks: At this time, staff and students of Hidden Valley High School are not required to wear masks. However, masks are optional for individuals if they so choose.

Murphy Creek Road: Please remember that we share this beautiful valley with the residents of Murphy Creek Road. It is extremely important to obey all traffic laws and posted speed zones for the safety of our students, as well as our neighbors. Please do your part in keeping Murphy Creek Road a beautiful and clean roadway for the residents and the students and the guests of Hidden Valley High School.

Registration required for all students: All students must be registered each year for Three Rivers Schools. Through our website you can go into your Parent Vue account and update any new information and read our policies and procedures. If you need help resetting your Parent Vue password, please contact the front office at 541-862-2124.

Start and End times: Hidden Valley High School will start each day at 7:45. A five minute bell will ring at 7:40. It is the expectation that all students will be ready and in their assigned classroom/seat before the tardy bell rings at 7:45. Seventh period will end at 3:40. Students are expected to load the buses immediately following the school day so that buses can roll out at 3:50 for additional student pick up and a prompt return to home.

Food, closed campus: Please remember that Hidden Valley High School, along with all TRSD schools, has a closed campus. Students cannot leave school grounds for lunch. Students cannot use UberEats or DoorDash to bring food to the campus. If you choose to drop off food, please report directly to the office.

Visitors: Parents are welcome at HVHS. All visitors, including guardians, must first come to the main office and arrange the conditions of their visit. Other high school students will not be allowed to visit, except for pre-arranged special circumstances. All visitors must wear a visitor's pass when they are in the school. These passes can be found in the front office upon check in.

Checking out students: Only parents, or individuals that are listed on their student's emergency contact list, may check out a student.

Fall Sports Passes: Fall sport passes are now available. You can save dollars and time waiting in lines for Football and Volleyball games. There is a Football Family Pass, a Volleyball Family Pass and a Year Long Family Pass available for purchase. Visit our website for all athletic schedules. Students may also purchase an ASB sticker, in advance, that will get them into all home games.
