### **Collaboration Projects:**

We have been working closely with Blackfeet Community College over the last couple of months to provide job training for our BHS students to get them workforce ready. This summer, BCC will be offering a Certified Nursing Assistant's training. We are also trying to secure funding for a Flagger training as well.

#### **GEAR UP Surveys:**

#### **Purchase of NEPRIS License:**

We purchased this on-line platform that gives us access to career professionals from all over the U.S. Our primary goal is to create a virtual Career Day at both BMS and BHS as well as make this resource available to all staff that can schedule their own guest speakers. Nathan has also been utilizing this resource in his GEAR UP Google classroom at BMS.
