Spring NAEP: RGS was selected at random to conduct the NAEP pilot school for Math and ELA with 50 of our 4th grade students in February. The NAEP is the National Assessment of Educational Progress is a common measure of student achievement by state. The test is administered by NAEP staff at RGS with RGS staff and admin supporting students during the 2 hours testing period.
