

Paragraph for Board Memo:

The Better Government Association (via NBC5 email address) requested the following records:

“Records sufficient to show all cases where a plaintiff or plaintiffs were paid -- by verdict, settlement or satisfaction -- as the result of a sexual misconduct or sex/gender discrimination claim, from January 1, 2008 to the present.

The records should each include:

- A) A case number; name of party paid; payment amount; fees and costs (if kept separately); the allegations in the case, and the specific department, agency, and/or individual(s) involved in the litigation.
- B) All money paid to outside counsel in each case, including pending cases and cases with no settlement or judgment. The records should also include information about settlements or payments that did not involve a court of law.

In addition, I am requesting all records of separation agreements and/or payments to individuals who stopped working in your government, department or agency after being accused of sexual misconduct, harassment, or sex/gender discrimination.”

This FOIA request was received Aug. 7, 2018, and responded to on Aug. 14, 2018. It took two District employees a total of 1 hour 30 minutes (\$77.63) to respond to this FOIA request. Total attorney time equaled 1.5 hours (\$367.50).
