East Trip Budget – March 2009

(1.) **Spending money**: I am NOT collecting meal money for your lunches, the first and last day's dinners, and any airport snacks. I encourage you to bring snack food if it fits in your luggage, like granola bars, peanuts, jerky, etc. Liquids can not be brought in to terminal or on the plane at this time. You have 6 lunches to buy at food courts, not counting the two travel days. You have two dinners and two breakfasts to buy as well. At a minimum, you need \$70 set aside. When you add snacks, drinks, etc., I would advise \$80.00 for these meals. Souvenirs are cheapest in Wash. DC from the street vendors. I will also take you to a store by Ford's Theater which has excellent souvenirs for good prices. It is up to you how much you spend on souvenirs, but don't be carrying around a big wad of cash. Traveler's checks and debit cards are safe, but cash at lunch time is much faster.

(2.) <u>Total Projected Cost</u> – Eugene: \$865-900 – (not including your own meal money) *Remember, our plane tickets are not confirmed because we are going to buy them on the Internet. We don't get that price unless we buy them right away and have to pay full price for them with no deposits. This price can change up or down very fast. You will need to have \$400.00 in your trip account by Thanksgiving for the plane ticket, which needs to be paid no later than Nov. 25th. I am going to buy plane tickets. Let me know if you would rather buy your own. The rest of the money can be paid in installments, or however you want to do it. But all money must be given to the book keeper by March 6th, 2009.
