## **RATIONALE/DISCUSSION:**

As part of the review of business services, request for proposals for garbage & recycling hauling services have been reviewed by a committee. The committee was represented by Scott Wood, Maintenance Supervisor, Scotti Erickson, District Accountant, and Becky Nino, Administrative Assistant.
