## **Professional Development**

Each building has completed their own PD's relevant to the building needs. BMS and BHS still receive training in MATH/READ 180 and Systems 44. Due to the MATH 180 and Systems 44 not aligning to our new Math program we are moving to the ALEKS program. The ALEKS program is computer adapted to meet where the user is at. It is used to supplement and support the REVEAL math program. We are also considering using the ALEKS program. We are still working on PD needs for the summer and fall.

## **District Committees**

The social studies committee has decided on the Savaas social studies program. It rated high and incorporated many on-line resources. The elementary members felt this best met the needs of our students. Topics are covered more in-depth as opposed to covering many. Our science committee is still in the process of rating the various curricula. The K-5 committee members are leaning towards Amplify.

SBE is solidified their schedule for June. Do to the lack of in person learning we will revisit Math in addition to the new content areas. Writing has been a huge focus. MCLP grant funds are being used to bring more staff in during this time to make sure more people within the building have not only the trainings but also the input.
