## COVID Data

## Safe Learning Plan

The Safe Learning Plan—including Executive Orders 20-19, 20-82, 20-94, and 20-95—will continue to be in full effect for the remainder of the 2020-21 school year. This means you should continue following the Safe Learning Plan until whenever the last teacher contact day is for your individual school district or charter school.

No COVID protocols or mitigation strategies will be changing in the district at this time. Students and adults still need to wear masks, stay distant from one another, wash hands, and stay home if there are symptoms or are a close contact to a positive person.
