Mission Statement:

It is the goal of the Aztec Schools Hall of Honor to recognize Aztec Municipal School District Alumni and Staff that have distinguished themselves by their contributions in their fields of work/study, or to their community, in a manner that enhances student achievement and development. By honoring these positive role models, we hope to inspire current students. in their areas of studies as well-as extra-curricular opportunities.

Aztec Schools Hall of Honor Inductees

All Inductees must have graduated a minimum of 5 years prior to induction and must not be a current employee of the Aztec Municipal School District, and must meet at least one of following criteria:

- Must have excelled in activities and or a successful professional career within the District that promoted student excellence and growth, and exemplified Aztec, pride and spirit.
- Must have been recognized during his/her career by other peers, colleagues, media, and/or other school-related associations.
- Must demonstrate a long-standing commitment to servicing the school community.

Selection Committee:

The candidate must A selection committee member, during and following his/her career, must have exemplified the attitude and conduct that is a credit to the Aztec Municipal School District, and must meet the following criteria:

- Exemplary achievements and recognition in their chosen field that have positively contributed to student success.
- Outstanding citizenship or meritorious contribution to society in the educational field.
- 3. Exhibit qualities of leadership that contribute to student development and achievement.
- 4. Having made a meritorious contribution to society
- 5. The candidate must demonstrate the qualities listed above in a mannerthat will inspire the students of Aztec Municipal School District in the pursuitof excellence

Selection Committee: Consists Shall consist of seven representatives of different constituencies, age groups, gender, ethnicity, and sports interests professional backgrounds—(, and may include former coaches, administrators, teachers, or community advocates, and or business people).

The committee meets in February, March, April, and May of every year. Selection of inductees will take place every year in May. It The committee selects its chairperson, vice-chair and secretary and fills vacancies as needed. Member Committee member terms are to four years. It The committee keeps a written record of all proceedings. The committee's major responsibilities are to (1) establish criteria for election to the Hall of Honor. (2) encourage nominations; (3) publicize the Hall of Honor throughout the community; (4) review and evaluate nominations and select inductees, and (5) vote for filling Committee vacancies (5) schedule and conduct Inductions ceremonies.

Nominations and selections: Nominations <u>for inductees</u> may be <u>made at any timesubmitted</u> by any interested group or individual, including <u>elections</u> committee members, <u>by April 1st of every year. Nominations</u> must be sent to the Aztec Schools central office c/o the Superintendent of Schools <u>in writing</u>; it must include a resume of the nominee's accomplishments (comprehensive, detailed dates and related information, <u>including any news clippings, testimonials, videos, etc.</u>), as well as the nominee's address and <u>telephone numbercontact information</u>. The committee will induct <u>one individual per calendar year.</u> 5 the first year, 4 the second year, 3 the third year and 2 every year after that <u>one individual per year</u>. This will begin at Homecoming 2013 and be held each year during the football Homecoming game.

Awards: Plaques <u>for inductees</u> will be hung in the Long Hall on the East side of the High School Gymnasium. A duplicate plaque will be given to the individual inductee and/or family. Start-up funding will be provided by Aztec School district <u>in accordance with Board policies and regulations</u>; additional contributions will be sought from individuals or the community and will be so recognized on the plaques as sponsors.

Aztec Schools Hall of Honor:

categories and basic guidelines: Nominees must be in one of the following categories and must meet the established guidelines.

Participant: Must have graduated a minimum of 10 years prior to induction.

Must have excelled in academics, sports, and / or activities and exemplified Aztec, pride and spirit. Must have been recognized during career by peers, media, AHS coaches, NMAA, and / or state association. Must have achieved All State, North South Team, All District, national recognition, squad awards (MVP, etc.), and/or recognized by team or student body for leadership and involvement in other activities/athletics. After graduation, must have prolonged, successful career after high school. All honors will be considered.

Coach/Staff: Must have served AMSD for a minimum of 10 years. Must not be a current employee of Aztec schools. Criteria may include teaching and overall service to the

school/community, contribution to the lives of students and participants, win loss-records, play off appearances, championships won (district/state), National recognition, and general success.

Special Contributors: Individuals who have donated time and/or resources to the betterment of the academic, interscholastic athletic/activity programs over a period of time. May include community and staff member.
