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1. Introduction

On May 6, 2017, voters approved Collin College's \$600 million bond proposal to facilitate a long-range plan to accommodate the projected population growth in Collin County over the next two decades. The program consists of 4 new campuses and 2 new facilities.

On May 16, 2017, in a special session, the Board of Trustees granted the District President authority to enter and negotiate into contract with AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM) to provide Program Management Services to the Collin College 2017 Capital Improvement Program. On May 25, 2017, Collin College issued a Notice to Proceed to AECOM. As part of these services, AECOM will deliver a monthly report to provide status and progress of key aspects of the Program.

2. Executive Summary

The Program is progressing as planned with no major issues to report at this time.

Completed and Pending Items

- Drywall and MEP installations are on-going in the Academic Building, Trade Bar B, and Trade Bar C at the Technical Campus. Stair installations are complete in the Academic Building. Wall layout and metal stud installation is complete in Trade Bar B and Trade Bar C, and on-going in Trade Bar D. Site electrical and gas tie-ins are complete. Parking lot paving is on-going. Curtainwall, polycarbonate and swiss pearl exterior panel installation is on-going.
- MEP tie-in, drywall, glazing, millwork and masonry work is on-going in the buildings. Brown Street widening, intersection signalization, and bridge construction at the ephemeral stream is on-going at the Wylie Campus.
- JE Dunn Construction GMP #2 was approved by the Board of Trustees on January 28th

Items of close attention

• Construction schedules are being closely monitored to ensure completion of the Phase 1 projects by Fall 2020

Budget Summary

- \$410,290,407 of the \$600,000,000 has been committed to-date in the form of contracts with various vendors. This represents 68.38% of the overall program budget committed.
- \$295,220,480 of the \$410,290,407 committed amount has been expended to-date. This represents 71.95% of the commitments to date and 49.20% of the program budget.






