Lone Star TIA Update

Board Goal:

Purpose of Report

- The purpose of this workshop is to inform the Board regarding the 2013 Lone Star TIA (Technology In Action) conference hosted by Denton ISD on July 22nd and 23rd.

Objectives

- To provide Denton ISD staff with quality professional development that focuses on integrating technology into the learning environment so that our students are ready for 21st century success
- To provide our community (residents, business professionals, community members, etc...) with quality professional development that focuses on technology and productivity tools
- To provide outside-of-district educators with a low cost, quality professional development opportunity that features many of the large conference amenities (vendors, hands on workshops, certifications, etc...)
- To showcase Denton ISD as a leader of learning and promote the positive initiatives happening within our district

Operational Impact

- Lone Star TIA is currently a self-funded event (via participant registration, vendor sponsorships, and donations)
- District funds are not required to produce this event
- The conference was hosted for the first time at Ryan High School because of the rising number of participants.
- This annual conference is held in mid to late July (this year, the 22nd and 23rd)

Results

As a result of the Lone Star TIA conference:

- Denton ISD teachers will be better equipped to effectively incorporate technology into their learning environment
- Students will be better prepared for college and the 21st century workplace as their teachers are utilizing the strategies and techniques that TIA provides
- Outside-of-district stakeholders (community members, visiting educators, business professionals, etc...) will gain better insight into Denton ISD and the positive happenings that are taking place in our district/community

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- Economic impact to Denton by high lightening events and restaurants on the square and inviting food trucks to Ryan High School.
