Board policy directs that Planned Course Statements be provided for each course taught in grades 6-12. On behalf of the high schools, I am bringing forth the PCS's for new courses that will be offered for the 2009-2010 school year. Trigonometry will be offered district wide as an enhancement to our math program to better align our curriculum with upcoming diploma requirements. Conflict Resolution, American Literature, and History of Rock and Roll will only be offered at Illinois Valley High School this upcoming year.

With the decision to move to the trimester system, high school principals and staff spent extensive time discussing adjustments to their curriculum that would better engage students and align courses offered with the requirements of teacher liscensure and highly qualified issues.
