USE OF FEATURE FILMS/, VIDEOS, OR OTHER MEDIA

The Board recognizes the showing of commercially produced and rated feature films and videos may have a legitimate purpose in a school's educational program. However, sSince the content of these feature films, videos, or other media customarily is designed for general audience viewing, the Board feels certain precautions should be taken to ensure the showing of a particular film, videos, or other media is consistent with the educational values espoused by the district.

All copyright laws must be followed.

Films rated G, PG PG-13, R or other non-rated media may be shown as part of the school program. The Board directs administrative procedures be developed to accomplish this objective, including the provision that a parent of students in grades K-5 must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated PG or PG-13. A parent of students in grades 6-8 must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated PG-13. A parent of students in grades 9-12 must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated PG-13. A parent of students in grades 9-12 must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated PG-13. A parent of students in grades 9-12 must give prior consent before his/her student may view a film rated R. Films rated R may only be shown at grades 9-12. Administrative approval must be obtained before a feature film is shown at any grade level. that parents or guardians have the opportunity to preview a film when practically possible and that parents or guardians must give prior consent before their student views a film rated PG, PG-13 or R.

Any media materials that are not rated are subject to the approval of the administrator prior to viewing.
