BACKGROUND/RATIONALE:

The classrooms on the 2nd floor of the Administration Building in many cases still use the one piece student desk. Over the years this has become more and more problematic with some students just not able to fit in the desks. These old one piece desks don't allow for any sort of adjustment to better suit the students. Faculty has requested that we replace them with a student desk and separate chair. The College purchased this style desk before in the Science Building and in the new part of the Johnson Health Careers Building. The desks have performed well in both areas.
